

3gamma personal data policy

Introduction

Everyone has the right to the protection of personal data and at 3gamma we comply fully with our obligations under EU law.

This personal data policy explains how we treat the personal data you provide while visiting the 3gamma website and/or our social media channels. By using the website, you are accepting the terms of this policy; if you are not happy with these terms, you should not use this website.

What information does 3gamma collect?

The information we may collect as you use 3gamma's website falls into two categories:

1. Personal Data

This is information that identifies you, or can be used to identify or contact you. This may include your name and email address. This information is only collected if you voluntarily submit it to us, e.g. to register for a newsletter or an event.

2. Non-Personal Data

Like most websites, 3gamma gathers general, non-personal information on our visitors for statistical purposes. This cannot be used to identify or contact you.

How is this information used?

We use personal information for registration to 3gamma events and to send out surveys, newsletters and 3gamma Insights. 3gamma does not carry any third-party advertising, so your data is not being used for commercial targeting.

Does 3gamma share this information with others?

3gamma will never sell any personal data you submit to us to a third party. Information may be shared with third parties, such as our partners, that participate in our events. These third parties are bound by similar privacy and data protection requirements as 3gamma.

Personal data will only be released to external sources in order to comply with applicable EU laws, summonses, court or regulatory orders, or other statutory requirements.

Non-personal information may occasionally be used to compile statistics that may be shared with others - e.g. the number of visitors to the website, etc.

Security

While no data transmission over the Internet can ever be guaranteed to be 100% secure, 3gamma will take all reasonable steps (technically and organisationally) to protect your information. We will also work only with third parties with clear and suitable privacy and data protection policies of their own.
